

C. B. S. Cancels Programs

The Columbia Broadcasting System will continue its public demonstrations of color television in New York, the network announced yesterday. In addition, the network plans local demonstrations in other cities "in the early future."

Complying with the temporary restraining order of the United States District Court in Chicago, C. B. S. has canceled plans to start commercial network color video next Monday, when the programs would have been fed to the chain's Washington station.
